HEALED OF HEPATITIS B & NO MORE MISCARRIAGE

During a hospital visit, I was diagnosed with Hepatitis B, I refused to accept it, and I told the Doctor "No, It can't be". I left there, went to another hospital, still the results came out positive and I was prescribed medications. I heard the doctor say very many people are on this medication, but they have never been healed. This led me to be just in a state of confusion because I had experienced a miscarriage before in 2024, now again, the virus. I called Pastor Sarah, and every time I would call her she would, just say "just know who you are" even my branch pastors told me the same thing when I shared with them the situation. These words sank deep. But now, who am I? That is when the Holy Spirit comes in. I started meditating and reading books, as I took the medication. I made a vow in my heart to get healed and never to be a victim of that again. I would sometimes even forget to take the medicine but I

started to commune with the Holy Spirit, I would speak to the Holy Spirit, like in most cases, I'm alone at home, I start saying the Holy Spirit empowers me, He strengthens me, emboldens me. It was just nice, interesting, fellowshiping with the Holy Spirit. I stopped obsessing over the medication. Joy flooded in unexpectedly.

I got used to fellowshiping with the Holy Spirit and one day, I was just sitting on the couch in my house, and I'm like, But why am I so happy? I didn't even know why and the Holy Spirit tells me it is a victory note, because the doctor had told me that I should continue with the medication and that the next time I conceived, after three months, I needed to go to the hospital and they stitch the cervix to prevent another miscarriage. When I realized that, I had conceived again. I went to the hospital and during checkup; the Hepatitis B result came back negative. I was the happiest, very happy. The Doctors told me stop one medication due to the pregnancy and go back for a refill when it is finished.

The Holy Spirit asked me, "What do you want me to show you that you are healed after even the results came back negative". I told the Holy Spirit that whenever I take this medicine, I always throw up and it had happened many times. I said enough is enough. I never went back for a refill. I went back to the hospital and did a complete blood count and everything is fine. I didn't even go back for the stitching of the cervix. I am very fine and 37 weeks pregnant.

GIVE THE RIGHT OFFERINGS

“If you offer what is right, won’t you be accepted? But if you refuse to offer what is right, sin, the predator, is crouching in wait outside the door of your heart. It desires to have you, yet you must be its master.” Genesis 4:7 TPT

Globally, Christians have been presenting offerings to God, with many believing that these offerings would enhance their divine contact and blessings. However, it is imperative to examine whether God accepts just any offering. Empathically, the answer is no. The rationale for this is elucidated in our scripture.

Both sons of Adam offered sacrifices to God, but Cain’s offering was rejected because he didn’t offer what was right. This meant that Cain knew what was right to offer, but his rebellious attitude prevented him from doing so. ***“So then, anyone who knows the right thing to do and fails to do it is committing a sin.”*** Ya’akov (James) 4:17 CJB.

Giving to God and His work is always in His honour. However, if we simply give what we think is right,

rather than what He desires or what honours Him, our offering is not accepted by Him. So, how do we know what honours Him? The word of God lets us know what honours Him. Start by listening to your pastors' teachings, believing in their message on giving, and giving accordingly.

Of course, if you don't give according to the word of God, our theme verse lets us know that sin, the predator, is crouching in wait outside the door of your heart. It desires to have you, yet you must be its master. You will be jealous with those who are giving rightly.

Romans 1:17 TPT

The gospel is the only way humanity is transformed into divinity; it’s the only way natural men can become children of the Almighty God. It’s the only way sinners are turned into saints, and the only way man can become a member and part of the deity without their religious duties. Powerful!

Whenever this gospel of the Kingdom is presented

and taught, the righteousness of faith is revealed, lives are transformed, people are healed, habits are broken, relationships are restored, and burdens are lifted and destroyed. It's the message of righteousness in the gospel that energizes it to give salvation to those who believe it.

The righteousness of faith, as revealed by the gospel, is rooted in faith and love. Everything you do, from giving to prayer, fasting, and serving in church, is a direct result of faith and the love of Christ in your heart. As 1 John 4:19 states, we love Him because He first loved us. This love is reciprocated based on His faith and love in our hearts. Praise the Lord!

The righteousness I live by, is the righteousness of faith. It produces life, power, healing, freedom, and restoration in me. As I believe the gospel, burdens are lifted, habits are broken, and my life is continually transformed. Hallelujah

THREE KINDS OF RIGHTEOUSNESS

“For they being ignorant of God’s righteousness, and seeking to establish their own righteousness, have not submitted to the righteousness of God. For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to everyone who believes.” Romans 10:3-4 NKJV

As a Christian, you must know the three kinds of righteousness so that you can always check yourself whether you are living the kind of righteousness imparted to your spirit by the Holy Ghost.

The first kind of righteousness is the righteousness of the law. The righteousness of the law cannot be attained because its requirements are too high for any man but purposefully given to lead men to Christ. This is the kind of righteousness expected from the Jews because the law of Moses was given to them. The law was their standard and measure of right and wrong. Philippians 3:9.

The second kind of righteousness is ***“own righteousness or self righteousness”*** Romans 10:3, this stan-

Standard and measure of righteousness sets a person based on the level of information of right and wrong as prescribed by the country and culture one lives in. Christians who haven't understood God's way of making men right, have also established their own righteousness based on their judgement and understanding of the word of God and they are busy trying to attain it.

The third kind of righteousness is the righteousness of faith, "But the righteousness of faith speaks in this way, ***"Do not say in your heart, 'Who will ascend into heaven?'" (that is, to bring Christ down from above)***" Romans 10:6 NKJV, this is the righteousness that the new creation has received.

Our faith in Jesus Christ's work on the cross determines our righteousness, not our actions. If you've been born again, stop trying to be righteous by your deeds. Believe that you've been made righteous by God in Christ Jesus. Glory.

CONFESSION

My righteousness is not determined by my actions but by my faith in the finished work of Christ on the cross. I have been made righteous by God in Christ Jesus, and I live from this truth _ not toward it. Glory to God

The gospel is only profitable to those who encounter it and believe in the message of Christ's finished work. We must understand that if we could do something to earn God's acceptance, we wouldn't need Christ. To live out God's dream for humanity, as revealed in the gospel of Christ, we must have a clear understanding of righteousness.

Righteousness, as revealed in our opening scripture, is a gift from God's love. It's not something we earn or can achieve through our efforts, as it's beyond human capabilities to attain.

When we confess the Lordship of Jesus Christ over our lives, we receive this righteousness immediately. We become as righteous as Jesus is, and this state of righteousness remains constant. It doesn't decrease,

increase, grow, or mature. However, when a Christian misunderstands this message of righteousness, they may try to please God through their actions. This doesn't make them more righteous than they already are.

When you were born, you were born with the human nature. Nothing you do can make you less human because you are born with it. The same is true with righteousness. When you are born again, you are born with the righteous nature. Praise God.

CONFESSION

By grace, I reign as a king in life, walking in freedom and enjoying the gift of perfect righteousness. I am born again with the nature of Christ, and His righteousness is my reality. I live daily in the consciousness of this gift, empowered to experience life as God intended. Glory to God!

Righteousness working in a man will produce three things according to our opening scripture: 1)- Peace 2)- quietness and 3)- confident trust forever. Peace is translated from a Hebrew word Shalom Shalom, which means completeness, soundness in body, prosperity, health, welfare and tranquility.

Righteousness brings perfection in your life and everything around you. Completeness in your health, finances, marriage, ministry, business, character and more. That inner sense of calm, serene or worry free that transcends human understanding as stated in Philippians 4:7.

Look at this amazing revelation given to the great Apostle of Christ in Romans 5:1 TPT ***“Our faith in Jesus transfers God’s righteousness to us and he now***

declares us flawless in his eyes. This means we can now enjoy true and lasting peace with God, all because of what our Lord Jesus, the Anointed One, has done for us.”

Because of the righteousness of God that was transferred to us through our faith in Jesus, we enjoy true and lasting peace with God and we are flawless in His sight. The effect of this everlasting righteousness is everlasting peace. Hallelujah.

EFFECT OF RIGHTEOUSNESS 2

“And the effect of righteousness will be peace [internal and external], And the result of righteousness will be quietness and confident trust forever.” Isaiah 32:17 AMP

The second thing righteousness produces according to Isaiah 32:17 is quietness. It is close to Peace but not exactly. Quietness is a certain divine calmness that is brought into your life as a result of righteousness. Even in the face of opposition you are not moved because you know what you are made of.

When kings plot against the Lord and His anointed, the one with everlasting righteousness laughs. ***“The kings of the earth set themselves, and the rulers take counsel together, Against the LORD, and against his anointed, saying, let us break their bands asunder, and cast away their cords from us. He that sitteth in the heavens shall laugh: The Lord shall have them in derision.”*** Psalm 2:2-4 KJV

This mentality comes with the righteous nature you got when you became born again. If you are not walking in the reality of it, it is because of ignorance_ but now you know. Look at Job 5:22 NLT: ***“You will laugh at destruction and famine; wild animals will not terrify you.”*** This can only be possible if you know you are made of what God is made of - righteousness.

The Lord wants us His children to copy Him ***“THEREFORE BE imitators of God [copy Him and follow His example], as well-beloved children [imitate their father].”*** Ephesians 5:1 AMPC. Don't cry or mourn over destruction or famine, but rather laugh it off. Respond the way your father would. He gave us His nature so that we may live just as Him, in glory.

CONFESSION

I am righteous and full of glory, just as my beloved father is. My response to any circumstances is just as God would respond to them. I refuse to fear or yield to it because the righteous nature has produced in me quietness forever. Hallelujah.

EFFECT OF RIGHTEOUSNESS 3

“And the effect of righteousness will be peace, And the result of righteousness will be quietness and confident trust forever.” Isaiah 32:17 AMP.

Do you know that there are Christians who aren't bold and confident enough to communicate in large crowds? They haven't embraced the righteous nature they received. The third effect of righteousness is confidence and assurance.

Righteousness gives the Christian a sense of security and safety that nothing else can. If you can stand before God without any sense of inferiority, guilt, or condemnation, then in whose presence can you be insecure or unsafe or intimidated? If you can qualify before God, then you qualify before anyone.

The assurance that all is well comes from this knowledge of your oneness with the father. When we discuss righteousness and tell people that it is the

same nature of God that we have, it may leave some questions in their minds. Let us further tell them; we don't just have the same nature, we are joined together with the Lord.

We share the same nature and same life; we are mingled together with Him. When you look at us, you see Him and when you look at Him, you see us. ***“But the one who joins himself to the Lord is mingled into one spirit with him.”*** 1 Corinthians 6:17 TPT

This is what gives us confidence and assurance beyond what the security personnels of the president of the greatest nation can give him. We are sure of how things will end with us, working together for our good ***“We are assured and know that [God being a partner in their labor] all things work together and are [fitting into a plan] for good to and for those who love God and are called according to [His] design and purpose.”*** Romans 8:28 AMPC

CONFESSION

I embrace the righteousness of God that I have received through Jesus Christ. The effect of this righteousness in my life is peace, divine calm, and confident trust forever. I walk in quietness and calm assurance, unshaken by opposition, fear, or intimidation. Hallelujah

SUBMIT TO GOD'S RIGHTEOUSNESS

“And since they’ve ignored the righteousness God gives, wanting instead to be acceptable to God because of their own works, they’ve refused to submit to God’s faith-righteousness. For Christ is the end of the law. And because of him, God has transferred his perfect righteousness to all who believe.” Romans 10:3-4 TPT

Our understanding of the word of God in the light of what our Lord Jesus Christ has accomplished is very important. You can’t claim to have understood the word of God if your understanding is not consistent with the provisions of the gospel of Christ Jesus.

What I mean is, as a Christian, your interpretation and application of the scriptures must depend entirely on Jesus Christ’s complete work on the cross. Never think you can improve what Christ has accomplished. Remember, complete wholeness is equal to Christ’s work plus zero works. We were born into rest, so continue in rest.

It’s important not to ignore God’s way of making men righteous and instead try to establish your own

system through your own works. This is how they rejected God's righteousness, and sadly, many Christians are like this today.

Accept that Christ's actions alone were sufficient for your health, wealth, ministry, family, and everything else you desire. 2 Peter 1:3 reveals that all things we need for life and godliness have been given to us freely. Notice the difference between **'given'** and **'will be given'**; it was done before you were born. Submit to the righteousness of rest, which is the righteousness of faith.

God transferred His own righteousness to you the moment you believed the message of the gospel of Jesus Christ. Even now, you can simply declare, ***"I receive my healing in the name of Jesus Christ,"*** and it will be so. Praise God.

PRAYER

Heavenly Father, Thank You for the gift of righteousness that comes through faith in Your Son, Jesus Christ. I acknowledge that your perfect work on the cross is sufficient for my life, health, family, and every need. Thank you Lord, for transferring your perfect righteousness to me the moment I believed. I rest in your love, grace, and power. In Jesus' name, Amen

YOU ARE HIS RIGHTEOUSNESS

“For God made the only one who did not know sin to become sin for us, so that we might become the righteousness of God through our union with him.” 2 Corinthians 5:21 TPT

Our opening verse is one of the most powerful utterances heaven ever permitted. There’s a big difference between being made righteous and being made the righteousness of God. To be made righteous means you are declared not guilty, you are acquitted and declared innocent.

On the contrary, the righteousness of God is what describes, determines and reveals how God is righteous. The righteousness of God is the measure of His righteousness. If you want to know how God is righteous, you look at that thing or person. They define God’s righteousness and this is who God made you when you declared the Lordship of Christ Jesus over your life.

Think about it a little bit, who is declared not guilty,

acquitted or innocent? The person who is either a criminal or was suspected and was arrested and arrayed in the court of law. A righteous man can be suspected to have committed crimes or offenses but the righteousness of God cannot.

You are the righteousness of God in Christ Jesus; this is what the new creation really is. He has no past. Just as a baby cannot be suspected of murder, the new creation cannot be accused.

Remember, our theme verse doesn't say we work our way to become the righteousness of God but rather through the substitutory work of Christ, we were made the righteousness of God in Christ Jesus. This is your present hour state and status. Hallelujah, glory to Jesus.

CONFESSION

I live and walk as one who reflects God's rightness in thought, word, and action. I am the standard of righteousness in my world because I am joined to Christ. Today, I walk in confidence, authority, and freedom, knowing I am fully His righteousness. Hallelujah!

AWAKE TO THE RIGHTEOUSNESS

“Awake to righteousness, and sin not; for some have not the knowledge of God: I speak this to your shame.” 1 Corinthians 15:34 KJV

Many years ago, when I was at the university, I was part of the student leadership in the Christian Union. When the teaching of righteousness came strong to this country, I resisted it, fought it so hard and preached against it. I used to pray and fast to stop certain habits like lust but it could not, sometimes after finishing a long prayer fast, that’s when the lust came in even stronger. I was very frustrated and I struggled living for God.

One day, I decided to talk to the Lord concerning this message because when I listened to my spiritual father, the man of God Pr. Chris, he explained righteousness in a way that was different, it came with great clarity and much understanding. I asked the Lord Holy Spirit to teach and reveal this truth to me, I was amazed at how He helped me.

When I was fighting the message, I was fully righteous as Jesus is but I was asleep or in a state of drunkenness to this righteousness nature. ***“1 Corinthians 15:34 AMPC says Awake [from your drunken stupor and return] to sober sense and your right minds, and sin no more.”*** The reason I was sinning and struggling with sin is because I wasn't alive to righteousness, once I woke up to my righteous nature, the lust and every ungodly habit stopped. Glory to God, I became aware that I don't need to do anything to please God because God was already pleased with what Jesus Christ did for me.

You may be in the same state of spiritual confusion. Check your understanding of righteousness and that's why I am writing this message by the Spirit to help you. Submit to God's way of making men right with Him, and you will be totally free from any ungodly habits. Blessed be God

CONFESSION

I walk in sobriety of spirit, clarity of mind, and freedom from sin. Ungodly habits, lust, fear, and shame have no power over me, for I am awake to the reality of righteousness. I live in the consciousness of my righteous nature, and my life reflects God's holiness, power, and love.

TREES OF RIGHTEOUSNESS

“to appoint unto them that mourn in Zion, to give unto them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they might be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the LORD, that he might be glorified.” Isaiah 61:3 KJV

When you look at any tree, the most beautiful part is the branches. That’s where the leaves, the flowers, and ultimately the fruits are. The glory of any plant is in the branches. In John 15:5 KJV, it says **“I am the vine, ye are the branches: He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without me ye can do nothing.”** This is consistent with the prophecy of Isaiah in our opening verse.

We are trees of the righteousness bearing righteous fruits **“being filled with the fruits of righteousness which are by Jesus Christ, to the glory and praise of God.”** Philippians 1:11 NKJV. Because of righteous nature, we produce righteous works.

You cannot do right unless you have been made righteous. Right living is a result of righteousness in

your spirit but some think right living produces righteousness but it can never. I used to think and live like that until the Lord Holy Ghost helped me.

Our opening scripture says “...**that they might be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the LORD, that he might be glorified.**” Isaiah 61:3 KJV. That He (the LORD) might be glorified. Apostle John says the same thing “**By this My Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit; so, you will be My disciples.**” John 15:8 NKJV. Bear much fruit and bring glory to our Master Jesus Christ.

What are these fruits of righteousness? Anything that comes out of you such as words, praise, your giving, souls you won to Christ that are consistent with the doctrine of Christ. They are not duties but rather things which flows from you by reason of your oneness with Christ, glory.

CONFESSION

I am a tree of righteousness, planted by the LORD, and I am flourishing in His presence. The beauty of my life—the fruits, the praise, the words, and the acts of righteousness—flows naturally from the righteous nature God has given me. I am a living testimony of God’s glory, a flourishing tree of righteousness, planted by the Lord.

DON'T BE QUIET

Have you met someone from the so-called important nation or certain reputable social group or tribe? They always want to talk about their country, tribe or group because they know and think they are valuable and important. King David said in our opening scripture, ***"I have not concealed Your righteousness within my heart, but I have proclaimed it to a great crowd."***

This should be your mentality; how can you receive this nature of righteousness and be silent with it? Start sharing with your neighbors, friends, relatives, classmates or people at your work place the tranquility, security and rest that righteousness has produced in your life. Begin by testifying to them about the impact of the message of righteousness on your life.

“I don’t keep it a secret or hide the truth. I preach of your faithfulness and kindness, proclaiming your extravagant love to the largest crowd I can find!”

Psalms 40:10 TPT. This year, plan with other Christians in your PM or Zone, organize an outreach and go tell the message of His righteousness. Don’t keep it a secret because Jesus Christ didn’t die in secret, He was crucified on a hill, so you also proclaim the message on the mountain top. Make it your life commitment this year 2026.

“I tell everyone everywhere the truth of your righteousness. And you know I haven’t held back in telling the message to all.”

Psalms 40:9 TPT. Tell it to everyone everywhere the truth of His righteousness within, and don’t assume that those who are preaching are preaching what you know. Tell them, God already reconciled them, He is not counting their sins against them 2 Corinthians 5:19. Be radical, resolute and audacious about this message, hallelujah.

CONFESSION

Romans 5:17 NKJV.

Many of God’s people want to live the life that Christ died and brought them into, but either many have not been taught or have not been taught well. Success in the Kingdom is a function of the right and accurate knowledge of God’s word, not how long someone has been born again. And I am not talking about head knowledge but revelation knowledge given by the Lord Holy Ghost.

In every relationship, each of you must wrap around yourself the apron of a humble servant. Because: God resists you when you are proud but multiplies grace and favor when you are humble.”*** I Peter 5:5 TPT. As you collect more grace, learning the word of God through church, private messages, and various ministry platforms, you'll be empowered to reign in life.

CONFESSION

I reign in life by the abundance of grace and the righteousness of God flowing through me. Today, I step into my inheritance of victory, authority, and divine favor, walking boldly as a child of the Most High. Hallelujah! I reign in life through Christ Jesus!

SACRIFICES OF RIGHTEOUSNESS

“Bring to Yahweh the sacrifice of righteousness and put your trust in him.”Psalms 4:5 TPT

Why do new creations give to God? If they’re truly one with Christ and joint heirs, how does their giving bring prosperity, as we’ve been taught in church? Our opening scripture mentions sacrifice of righteousness. What is it? It involves not only the rightness of the sacrifice but also the attitude, motives, and state of one’s spirit. Sacrifices involve quantity, which is why they’re called sacrifices. They’re statements in the spiritual realm that you’ve arrived.

Imagine a wedding meeting where everyone’s giving about 10 dollars, but then someone starts giving 1000 dollars with joy and celebration. That’s a sacrifice of righteousness. It makes a luxurious and generous giving. It’s the announcement of the arrival of generosity. When God gave, He gave us His very best and everything that He had. John 3:16 AMPC.

The Lord Jesus was a righteous sacrifice; He was offered on the mountain with joy and excitement by the father. ***“They shall call the peoples to the mountain; There they shall offer sacrifices of righteousness; For they shall partake of the abundance of the seas and of treasures hidden in the sand.”*** Deuteronomy 33:19 NKJV.

Mountain is figurative of height in spirit realm; it’s a level of faith of operation of a man who has understood Christ and His message. They shall partake of the abundance of the seas and treasures hidden in the sand; this is what sacrifices of righteousness produce.

These sacrifices aren’t offered in the valley but on a mountain top. They’re a declaration of wealth, not an offering to attract a blessing, yet they attract serious blessings. The Lord wants His children to give their best at every opportunity with love, joy, and celebration, just as the man at the wedding meeting. They’ll walk in untold financial blessing because our giving are keys that open the realms of financial wealth.

CONFESSION

I trust God fully with my resources, knowing that every sacrifice of righteousness brings glory to His name and aligns me with His abundance. I walk in financial favor, spiritual prosperity, and heavenly increase because I give righteously, joyfully, and faithfully. Hallelujah

Proverbs 29:7 NKJV.

When you study scriptures, you understand the way how the LORD thinks about the poor. He expects the righteous to copy His ways of thinking. In every country, cities and communities, there are poor people and God wants us to consider their cause.

The verse is giving us two pictures; the righteous knows what rightfully belongs to the poor in the event of executing justice, they should make sure the poor get justice or get what belongs to them, and the second picture is understanding the state of the poor and coming in to help them become better.

God always wants us to remember where we came from, look at Deuteronomy 10:19 AMPC ***“Therefore love the stranger and sojourner, for you were strangers and sojourners in the land of Egypt.”***

Remember what changed your life and make it available to the poor in your community. Maybe you can afford to pay a child to school, do it with commitment because that is one of the ways of considering their cause.

Finally, don't forget why you got the anointing in your life, to proclaim the gospel to the poor. ***“The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, Because He has anointed Me To preach the gospel to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, To proclaim liberty to the captives And recovery of sight to the blind, To set at liberty those who are oppressed;”*** Luke 4:18 NKJV.

Remember, all the other interventions in a poor man's life are very good but for lasting and true change, the poor need to receive the gospel because it's the gospel that brings divine transformation in their lives and families.

CONFESSION

I am a vessel of divine transformation, bringing lasting change, provision, and the message of salvation to those in need. I act with wisdom, compassion, and righteousness, and my life glorifies God by uplifting the poor and marginalized. I am aligned with God's heart, empowered to make a difference, and my actions reflect His justice and mercy every day.

“The righteous will shoot up like a palm tree. They will grow tall like a cedar in Lebanon. Planted in the house of the Lord, they will shoot up in the courtyards of our God. They will still produce fruit in old age. They will stay fresh and green.” Psalm 92:12-14 EHV.

Palm trees are plants that are not adversely affected by drought, unlike other plants. Their deep roots allow them to withstand storms, and they are not easily uprooted or blown down. The Lord compares the righteous to palm trees. Think about it – that’s how the Lord thinks of you, and that’s how you are.

Palm trees have an advantage of height, which gives them a great view of their surroundings. This allows them to see far away and be seen by those around them. That means as a righteous person, you have a clear vision and you are clearly visible for all to see you and this includes your business. You have been noticed, don’t try to make yourself seen.

The reason they prosper and remain productive is because they are planted in the Lord's courtyards. When others expire, the righteous continue to be productive. Don't let anyone despise your youth or say you are too old to do anything. If you are born again, you are righteous and God expects you to produce fruit.

You maintain your freshness and greenness. You continue to flourish: ***"Yes! Look how you've made all your devoted lovers to flourish like palm trees, each one growing in victory, standing with strength!"*** Psalms 92:12 TPT. Your strength doesn't abate; you continue to grow in victory because you are divinely fortified.

CONFESSIO

I continue to prosper and bear fruit, even in old age, because I am divinely fortified, flourishing in victory, and established in God's courtyards. I grow in strength, dignity, and favor, and my life is a testimony of God's faithfulness, provision, and righteousness.

Somebody said no matter how bad the economy in the jungle is, you will never find lions eating grass. Do you know we hailed from the lineage of the lion of the tribe of Judah. Revelation 5:5 EHV. We are kings; we don't weep. Instead, we reign over circumstances. As a Christian, you ought to know that you have a nature of rulership just as the lion of the tribe of Judah. Hallelujah.

Our opening verse lets us know that as Kings, we reign through righteousness. When you awake to the nature of righteousness, you stop crying in face of adversity and adversaries. Now you understand that all things are working together for your good (Romans 8:28) because of righteousness.

Reigning in life means victory over fear, lack, sin, and sickness. Righteousness places you above circumstances. Therefore, as a Christian, be conscious of your nature in Christ the same way lions are in the jungle. The Bible says; **“God has put us in charge of his handcrafted world.”** Psalm 8:6 (MSG)

Authority flows as a product of revelation. When righteousness is understood, dominion is expressed. Ephesians 2:6 KJV. Reign today—this is your inheritance. You are a victor; therefore, reign in life by the reason of your nature as King. Revelation 5:10 (KJV)

CONFESSION

I reign in life through righteousness. I walk in God-given authority. Grace empowers my dominion. I rule over circumstances and Christ’s victory is my daily experience in Jesus’ name, Amen.

Romans 10:6 (KJV) “But the righteousness which is of faith speaketh on this wise, Say not in thine heart, Who shall ascend into heaven? (that is, to bring Christ down [from above:]”

As Christians, our understanding of righteousness is fundamental to the functioning of our faith. Effective faith depends on a clear understanding of righteousness. Consider this: if you know you're unworthy of my presence due to your wrong doing, how bold will you approach me? Or if you challenge an enemy you believe has a stronger advantage, you'll inevitably lose.

The new creation possesses the righteousness of faith, a righteousness born from faith in Christ. Righteousness gives faith its voice because the righteous possess wisdom that guides their speech. As you mature in Christ, you speak from a position of authority, expressing your beliefs rather than relying on your senses. As the Bible states in 2 Corinthians 4:13 (KJV), **“We believe, and therefore speak.”**

Remember, this faith works by love, and love is the nature of the Father (1 John 4:8). So, it's not an eternal thing we try to get but rather all three; faith, love, and righteousness, are forces within the spirit of a born-again child of God. When you know that you are receiving what you are expecting on the account of Christ based on His love for you, faith thrives.

Today, let the righteousness of Christ define your faith. Choose to speak, act from the place of complete payment by Christ, ***“For God has proved his love by giving us his greatest treasure, the gift of his Son. And since God freely offered him up as the sacrifice for us all, he certainly won’t withhold from us anything else he has to give.”*** Romans 8:32 TPT. hallelujah!

CONFESSION

**I live by faith rooted in righteousness. I speak boldly from who I am in Christ. My faith is stronger every day. Doubt has no place in my heart, and I chose to please God by faith.
Amen.**

“But it is from Him that you have your life in Christ Jesus, Whom God made our Wisdom from God, [revealed to us a knowledge of the divine plan of salvation previously hidden, manifesting itself as] our Righteousness [thus making us upright and putting us in right standing with God], and our Consecration [making us pure and holy], and our Redemption [providing our ransom from eternal penalty for sin].” 1 Corinthians 1:30 AMPC

When you know that your righteousness is not the result of the things you do or don't do, that's the day you will become free from any kind of struggle. Your righteousness is a person, and He cannot be changed by what you do or don't do. He decided to be your righteousness before you were formed in your mother's womb. Powerful.

Look at our opening scripture; it lets us know that Christ is our righteousness. So, if you want to check or know how righteous I am, look at Christ. If I want to know how righteous I am, I look at Christ; if Satan is questioning your righteousness, tell him to look at Christ; He is your righteousness, case settled forever. Don't ever question your righteousness from this day forward because you will be questioning Christ's righteousness.

This truth dismantles insecurity that condemnations bring in your life and empowers your faith. You are not standing on your performance but on God's righteousness nature. Jeremiah 23:6 KJV says ***"The LORD our righteousness."***

God was not ashamed to become your righteousness because He authored redemption. Faith in Christ is faith in God's own plan. Your righteousness is as secure as God Himself. 1 Corinthians 1:30 NLT: ***"God has united you with Christ Jesus. For our benefit God made Him to be wisdom itself. Christ made us right with God; He made us pure and holy, and He freed us from sin"***.

This revelation changes how you approach God. You come boldly, not timidly. Faith ceases to struggle when righteousness is settled. Romans 5:17 TPT says ***"We reign in life through the gift of righteousness."*** Rest today knowing Christ is your righteousness. For Isaiah 54:17 NKJV says ***"Your righteousness is my doing."***

CONFESSION

Lord, You are my righteousness. I stand secure in what You have provided. My confidence is anchored in You. I reign in life through righteousness. I live boldly and freely in Jesus' name, Amen.

THE PERFECT SUBSTITUTION

“For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.” 2 Corinthians 5:21 (KJV)

Have you ever watched a sports game like football? When the coach realized one player wasn't fit enough to give the team an advantage and win, he substituted him with someone who could play better. This led to the winning of the game. That's exactly what God did. We couldn't match the strength, prowess, power, and ability of our adversaries, so He brought Jesus Christ in our place. We took His place on the bench.

He didn't become a sinner; he became sin. He took on our sinful nature, the force that makes us sin, and made it his own. The theme verse says he became sin; God removed man's sinful nature and made it his own, taking it to the cross of Calvary and giving man his nature of righteousness.

It was the nature of sin that made men sinners. This substitution took place on the cross, and He was nailed and condemned to death with the sins of the world. And that was the end of sin and death; both of them lost power over humanity except for ignorance.

As a Christian, don't use your imperfections to judge the perfection of Christ in you. You've been purchased with a price, as stated in 1 Corinthians 6:20 (KJV): ***“For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.”***

Jesus gave us what we needed to become what He is. Righteousness isn't something we strive for; it's something we receive by faith through Christ. When we believe this, shame and fear lose their power, and our confidence in God is restored. As a Christian, remember that we are in God's right standing, hallelujah!

CONFESSION

I am a child of God, born of him, and I have become the righteousness of Him. In him I live, move, and have my being. I stand before God accepted, justified, and complete in Jesus' name, Amen.

FREEDOM FROM SIN CONSCIOUSNESS

“There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus...” Romans 8:1 (KJV)

There is a difference between condemnation and conviction; condemnation is an accusation from the enemy of your soul about what you have done whereas conviction is the awareness brought to the consciousness of men to repent from their sins. The Holy Spirit neither convicts nor condemns you, the Holy Spirit convicts the world not the Christian of sin **“When he comes, he will convict the world about sin, about righteousness, and about judgment:”** John 16:8 EHV.

The consciousness of sin is more destructive than the act of sin itself because it is what leads one to the act of sin. Our mind is literally the control tower of our lives; what goes on in your mind is what determines the direction of your life. **“For as he thinketh in his heart, so is he:.....”** Proverbs 23:7 KJV. Become righteousness-conscious because that’s who you are.

Condemnation drives you away from God. Sin consciousness is spiritual amnesia—it forgets the finished work of Christ on the cross. God never intended believers to live under guilt. Redemption silenced the

accusation forever. Colossians 2:14 (MSG): “ ***the slate wiped clean, that old arrest warrant cancelled and nailed to Christ's Cross.***”

The man in Christ cannot be condemned because satan can't see him; he is inside Christ. Police can't arrest someone they can't see, and a judge can't sentence someone he cannot see, so the man in Christ can't be condemned because Christ is seen—hallelujah. This same understanding should guide your thinking and actions; there's nothing of darkness in you, so you can't sin. Think righteousness and live righteousness.

The Holy Spirit only reminds you of what Jesus Christ has taught—that's truth, not past sin. “***But the Helper will teach you everything and cause you to remember all that I told you. This Helper is the Holy Spirit that the Father will send in my name.***” John 14:26 ERV.

Any remembrance of past sin is the ministry of the adversary, so you must stop him before he gains control of your mind. You are not condemned—you are righteous. Live free. Think free. Pray free. John 8:36 ERV: “***So if the Son makes you free, you are really free.***” Hallelujah!

CONFESSION

I declare that I live free from condemnation. My conscience is cleansed by the blood of Jesus. I refuse guilt, shame, and accusation. I stand justified and accepted in Christ. Faith flows freely in my heart in Jesus' Name, Amen.

FELLOWSHIP THROUGH RIGHTEOUSNESS

“God is faithful, by whom ye were called unto the fellowship of his Son Jesus Christ our Lord.”

1 Corinthians 1:9 (KJV)

Fellowship can only be possible with creatures of the same nature. All through the Bible, we never read that God has fellowship with angels, though they are always in His presence. What is fellowship? It is translated from a Greek word *Koinonia*, which means sharing together, participation, or association.

But man could not have fellowship with a righteous God after his fall in the garden, and that’s one of the reasons he was driven from the garden. Man and God had totally different natures, which were enmity to each other, and therefore couldn’t have communion with one another.

Salvation didn’t restore to man what he had in Adam but created a new man in Christ in righteousness and true holiness, **“and that ye put on the new man,**

which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness. Ephesians 4:24 KJV. And it is this righteousness nature you were created with that gives you a place of fellowship with God.

God now is your first partner; you can now share anything and everything with Him. 1 John 1:3 (KJV): ***“... Truly our fellowship is with the Father, and with his Son Jesus Christ.”*** Why do we preach the gospel and why should you relentlessly preach it? Because it gives opportunity for people to receive eternal life, which has the righteousness nature and brings them into this fellowship of deities.

Fellowship is the atmosphere where there is no pressure on either party; you are sharing a glorious moment together. Revelation flows in such an atmosphere. Truth becomes alive in communion. This is why the Psalmist said in your presence there's fullness of joy: ***“You make me know the path of life; in your presence is unbounded joy, in your right hand eternal delight.”*** Psalms 16:11 CJB

Father, I thank You for restored fellowship. I enjoy unhindered communion with You. Righteousness qualified me for intimacy. I live daily aware of Your nature in me. My fellowship with You is sweet and continual in Jesus' name, Amen.

THE PURPOSE OF THE LAW

Now we know that whatever the law says, it says to those who are under the law, that every mouth may be stopped, and all the world may become guilty before God. '

Therefore by the deeds of the law there shall no flesh be justified in his sight: for by the law is the knowledge of sin. Romans 3:19-20 (NKJV)

The law was given by God with a clear and deliberate purpose—not to make people righteous, but to reveal their need for righteousness. According to Romans 3:19–20, the law speaks to those under it so that every mouth may be silenced and the whole world held accountable to God.

In other words, the law removes every excuse for self-justification. It exposes humanity's true condition by setting God's perfect standard and showing that no one can meet it through personal effort. Like a microscope, the law magnifies sin, making human imperfection undeniable.

By revealing sin, the law also exposes human helplessness. No matter one's status, discipline, or religious devotion, righteousness cannot be achieved by works.

This is not a flaw in the law, but its function. The law was never meant to save; it was meant to point. It points away from self-reliance and toward the need for a Savior. When people recognise that they cannot save themselves, their hearts become open to grace. Salvation begins where self-confidence ends.

Galatians 2:16 reminds us that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith in Jesus Christ. The law highlights this truth by showing that rituals and rules cannot change the heart. Instead, the law directs us to Jesus Christ, who fulfilled the law on our behalf.

Ultimately, the purpose of the law is fulfilled in Christ.

Every demand, obligation, and debt was satisfied through His death and resurrection. For the believer, the law no longer stands as a burden but as a testimony that righteousness is a gift, not an achievement. Understanding this brings freedom, peace, and gratitude, allowing us to live righteous lives not by striving, but by faith rooted in a loving relationship with God.

CONFESSION

I am justified by faith, not by the works of the law. I live from freedom, not striving; from faith, not fear; from gratitude, not guilt. My confidence is in Christ alone. I walk in righteousness because I am loved, redeemed, and complete in Him. Hallelujah

The righteousness of God is not purchased from supermarkets or online or any market. Neither can it be bought from someone. God’s word shows us how it is manifested or revealed— through the preaching and teaching of the gospel. Not just church sermons but the teaching of the gospel of Jesus Christ only, not any other gospel.

The 16th Verse of Romans 1, gives us the context. ***“For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ...”*** Romans 1:16 KJV. Very clear, the gospel of Christ not another one. What is the gospel of Jesus Christ? It’s the message of the purpose of His coming to the earth and His eternal plan for mankind.

When you have understood the message of righteousness, it becomes a force within you and this

If you do that weekly, you will realise you are much happier and fulfilled. Glory to Jesus, hallelujah.

We are the trophy of His victory over Satan and every element of the kingdom of darkness.

“Then Jesus made a public spectacle of all the powers and principalities of darkness, stripping away from them every weapon and all their spiritual authority and power to accuse us. And by the power of the cross, Jesus led them around as prisoners in a procession of triumph. He was not their prisoner; they were his!” Colossians 2:15 TPT. Notice what our Lord Jesus did to Satan and his demons, He shamed them in the open, and now we are a success, victorious, blessed and powerful. Hallelujah.

Training is for more mature children; it's impossible to train a baby. As a Christian, you must delight in

growing so that you can put the word of righteousness to use. Hebrews 5:14 NIV says, ***“But solid food is for the mature, who by constant use have trained themselves to distinguish good from evil.”*** Training is necessary for living this life of immortality, in the same way you are trained to live the human life.

The word of God was given to us for teaching, correction, rebuke, and training in righteousness. To live righteously and teach others this righteousness, you need to be trained in it. Throughout the month, you’ve been undergoing this training. Continue reading the devotional, attending Patria Movement Gatherings and Church services, and soon you’ll be fully equipped for every good work. So that the man of God may be complete and proficient, well fitted and thoroughly equipped for every good work. 2 Timothy 3:17 AMPC.
